Report on the Standalone Financial Statements

Opinion

We have audited the accompanying standalone financial statements of Tatanagar Transport Corporation Ltd. ('the Company') which comprise the Balance Sheet as at March 31, 2024, the Statement of Profit and Loss, and the Cash Flow Statement for the year then ended, and a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory information.
