# Note-1 1. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES:

#### a. <u>BASIS OF ACCOUNTING:</u>

#### c. DEPRECIATION AND AMORTISATION:

Depreciation on Fixed Assets has been provided in accordance with the provisions of Schedule II of the Companies Act, 2013 at the rates specified for the Balance Life of the Asset. Deferred tax is measured using the tax rates and the tax laws enacted or substantially enacted as at the reporting date. Deferred tax liabilities are recognised for all timing differences. Deferred tax assets in respect of unabsorbed depreciation and carry forward of losses are recognised only if there is virtual certainty that there will be sufficient future taxable income available to realise such assets.

### h. <u>PROVISIONS AND CONTIGENCIES:</u>

A provision is recognised when the Company has a present obligation as a result of past events and it is probable that an outflow of resources will be required to settle the obligation in respect of which a reliable estimate can be made.
